This unit examines the core notions and practices found within traditional and contemporary Christian spirituality and witness. It investigates the fundamental beliefs and great spiritual seekers that have shaped Christian spirituality along with the call to cultivate spiritual growth through holiness, contemplation and awareness of mystery. It examines emerging contemporary spiritualities and practices with reference to Jesus as the model for the spiritual life and pastoral care. The unit also explores the active dimension of spirituality, the role of community, the invitation to transformation, and the challenge of justice and compassion, all within the context of mission and ministry.

Dr Peter Mudge has more than 32 years experience working with both primary and secondary RE teachers across five NSW dioceses. Within the field of spirituality he has taught a significant number of courses on spirituality, spiritual life formation, transformative learning, and the spiritual classics. He works at BBI as a Lecturer in Spirituality and Religious Education.

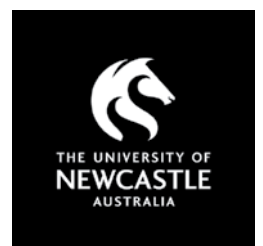
