The Fair Trade Fiesta is the key event in NSW for Fair Trade Fortnight, occurring this year 2 May – 17 May 2009, to raise awareness of the benefits of Fair Trade. These benefits include avoiding exploitation of communities & reducing the environmental impacts associated with production, particularly in the developing countries from which these goods are imported. Australia currently lags behind the western world in awareness of the supply chain impacts of its products. We recognize students have an enormous potential to shape the future and Fair Trade Fortnight is a wonderful opportunity to empower them with knowledge to make decisions in the future that do not exploit.

At the Fiesta there will be experts who have a wealth of knowledge about all aspects of Fair Trade from production to export, import, wholesale and finally retail sales. There will also be exciting stalls where your students can see the final products of Fair Trade plus meet the producers and importers of coffee, tea, chocolate, crafts and soccer balls. The Fair Trade Fiesta is also the perfect place to shop for Mother's Day presents with items starting from around \$5.

Especially for school groups we have a dedicated enriched education session your class(es) can book to join: 1.00pm to 3.00pm during which there will be Fair Trade presentations, a fair trade cinema plus a Question & Answer time. Entrance to the enriched education sessions is a voluntary donation fee of \$5 that will be used towards the promotion of Fair Trade (*for the evening session the admission is \$15*).

Fair Trade Fortnight is also an excellent opportunity for your school to both fundraise and bring awareness of Fair Trade to your community. If your school is planning an event for Fair Trade Fortnight, be sure to list the event on the 2009 Fair Trade Fortnight website.
