BBI is affiliated with the University of Newcastle and is a specialist theological provider with the largest array of tertiary Catholic distance theological programs in Australia. Faculty are conjoint appointments of the University of Newcastle.

Prospective candidates should be able to demonstrate commitment to the mission and Catholic ethos of the Diocese of Broken Bay and BBI.

Essential criteria:

- Doctoral qualifications in biblical studies
- Demonstrated excellence in undergraduate teaching and learning, and course writing

Desirable criteria:
