Fr Francis is currently the international leader of the Viatorian Fathers and is based in Rome. Fr Francis has a distinguished academic career in the area of liturgy at the Catholic Theological Union, Chicago.

Fr Driscoll is Associate Professor of Theology at Notre Dame, Indiana and his major interests are medieval liturgy and sacramental theology, most notably in the Carolingian period. He has also served the Bishops' Committee on the Liturgy, a standing committee of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, as a liturgical advisor.



The introduction of the new Missal will present significant challenges for presiders at liturgy. Frs Francis and Driscoll will lead us in understanding the texts and the reason for changes and background to the renewal of the Missal. This will lead to positive outcomes for parish communities in implementing a call to worship in a renewed way.
