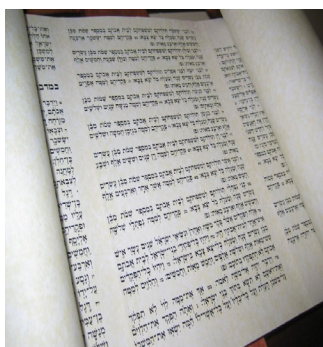
A workshop that invites you to:

What is Light of Torah?

Light of Torah is a network of Catholics who engage in Torah reflection. As a lay movement our purpose is to facilitate a grassroots awakening to the riches of the Old Testament through reflection on the Torah in homes, parishes and small community settings. [In its specific sense, Torah refers to the first five books of the bible.]

We do so with attention to the biblical insights and traditions of the Jewish people—our ancestors in faith and their present-day descendants—through whom God was revealed in history and we have received Jesus, the Living Torah.

We seek to draw closer to Jesus and his people by learning more about the Scriptures he loved and the way in which he, as a Jew, approached them.
