Most recently, John was Chief Scientist and Chair of Department of Natural Resources Science and Information Board, and Adjunct Professor in Agriculture and Natural Resource Management at Charles Sturt University. John has extensive experience in providing national and international leadership in the area of natural resource management, particularly in agricultural production and its environmental impact.

John Williams is also a lay leader and preacher in the Kippax Uniting Church in Canberra.
